


<p><u>Geography</u></p> <p>We will locate Dartmoor on maps and identify how different maps of the area give us different information. We will be taught what the key physical features of Dartmoor are. Year 4 will gain a good understanding of the settlements on Dartmoor and begin to understand why they are located where they are. We will be studying the river Plym with a focus on water supply to humans and animals. The children should also explore how landscape and land use has changed over time.</p>		<p><u>Science</u></p> <p>In Science, Year 4 will be exploring Rocks. We will compare and group together different kinds of rocks on the basis of their appearance and simple physical properties. We will describe in simple terms how fossils are formed when things that have lived are trapped within rock. We will also be looking at Living Things and their Habitats. We will learn that living things can be grouped in a variety of ways. The children will explore and use classification keys to help group, identify and name a variety of living things in their local and wider environment as well as recognise that environments can change and that this can sometimes pose dangers to living things.</p>

<p><u>Maths</u></p> <p>This half term, we will be moving on from fractions and looking at decimals. We will learn how to write and represent decimal numbers. We will also be learning how numbers are divided by 10 and become decimal numbers.</p>	<p><u>English</u></p> <p>Our book this term is 'Mouse Bird Snake Wolf' by David Almond. We will be learning new vocabulary, creating our own creatures in a new world and we will be writing a persuasive speech on a new mythical creature.</p> <p><u>PSHE</u></p> <p>Our Jigsaw piece this term is 'Relationships'. We will look at jealousy, love and loss, memories, getting on and falling out and celebrating relationships with people and animals.</p>	<p><u>Swimming</u></p> <p>For 3 weeks we will be swimming. Every Year 4 child will be placed in a swimming group. They will learn a range of swimming skills suited to their swimming ability and taught by professional swimming teaching instructors.</p> <p><u>Computing</u></p> <p>We are meteorologists! They will use simple algorithms and a variety of software to present weather.</p>
