I have previously studied World War I, and the events that led up to World War II, as part of a whole school theme to celebrate 100 years since Armistice Day.

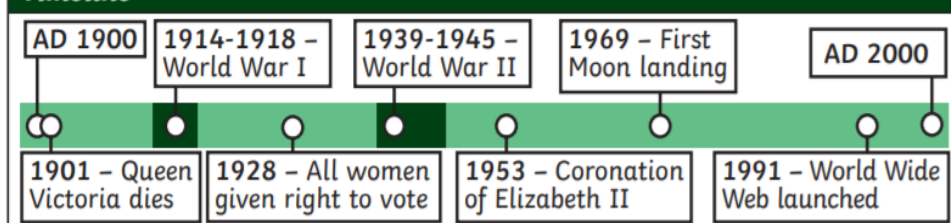

- The leader of Germany (Adolf Hitler) had plans to take over other countries.
- In March 1938, Germany annexed Austria, which worried other countries
- On 29th september 1938, British, French, Italian and German leaders signed a treaty called the Munich Agreement.
- This allowed Hitler to annex the Sudetenland (an area of Czechoslovakia) if he agreed not to invade anywhere else.
- In August 1939, Hitler broke the agreement and invaded the rest of Czechoslovakia and Poland.
- Britain, France and Poland had made a pact to support each other, so Britain and France declared war on Germany.

Vocabulary

Allies	The United Kingdom, France and Poland (later joined by other countries) who fought against the Axis.
Axis	The Axis powers were originally Germany, Japan and Italy.
Nazi Party	A German political party with racist and anti-Jewish ideas led by Adolf Hitler
Czechoslovakia	A European country. Now two countries: The Czech Republic and Slovakia
Propaganda	Information designed to promote a political idea or opinion
Annex	To take another country's land and make it part of your country

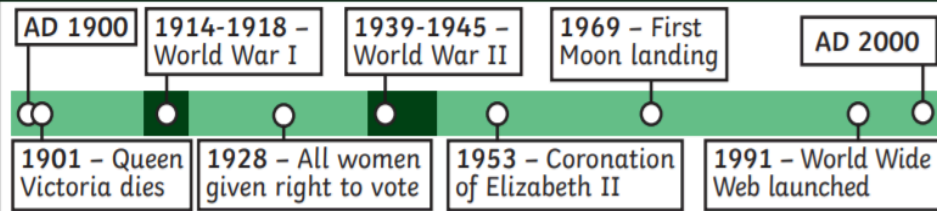
