Foundation Stage Learning Leaflet Term 5



This leaflet will give you information about some of the things your child is learning this term. Other things we learn during the week will be shared via 'Google Classroom' as a learning presentation.

We will learn the story of 'Goldilocks and the 3 Bears'



Through this story, we will

- think about how to get on with others
- think about sensible things to say and do if we have a problem
- develop our understanding that people may have different opinions to our own.
- explore the features of story through 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears'.
- use the story to consider the actions of the characters and possible consequences and solutions
- develop our understanding of what the police do and how they help us
- consolidate and develop our understanding and use of language to compare different sizes

The children have also thought about what they want to do or learn this term.

Here are **some** of their ideas:

Make some more porridge for the bears

Make the bear family and Goldilocks

Make cupcakes with a bear on it... or we could make bear biscuits.

Make a new chair for Baby bear

Help Baby bear feel better. We could make him a card or toy to go to sleep with.

Look for more clues.

We will continue to **revisit** the letter sounds that we have learnt and practise using them to read and write simple words and simple sentences.

Children **may** start to learn **some** of the set 2 letter sounds below

ay, ee, igh ow, oo, oo ar, or, air ir, ou, oy

There will be **supporting videos** and **activities** posted regularly on 'Google Classroom' which you can access. We will also send the sounds your child is specifically learning

In maths, we will



Develop our subitising skills but also recognise when groups may be too large to subitise.

To arrange larger groups of objects into regular patterns to support counting.

To recite numbers up to 20 and beyond including starting counting from different numbers

To develop accuracy in counting objects to at least 20.
