Reading Books

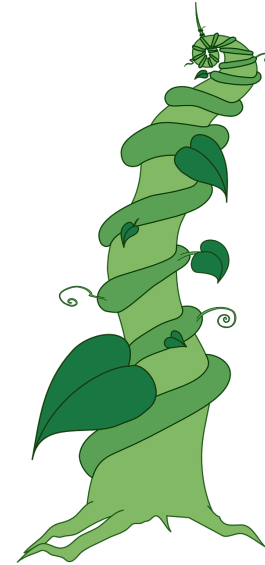
Just a quick reminder about when the reading books should be brought back to school.

Foundation Stage Learning Leaflet Term 4



This leaflet will give you information about some of the things your child is learning this term. Other things we learn during the week will be shared via 'Google Classroom' as a learning presentation.

We will learn the story of 'Jack and the Beanstalk'



Through this story, we will...

- learn about how plants grow and about the life cycle of a plant
- plant a variety of seeds and carefully observe what happens to them over time
- use our observational skills to draw with detail
- extend our learning about where food comes from
- learn about foods that help keep us healthy
- learn about different coins and their value
- learn how to keep our money safe
- develop our discussion skills through talking about Jack's actions in the story and if he was right to take the Giant's things

During the term, we will also visit a working farm. Here we will learn about the food that comes from a farm and how it gets from field to fork.

The children have also thought about what they want to do or learn this term.

Here are **some** of their ideas:

Make a beanstalk

Make a castle
for the Giant

Think of a different way
to get up to the Giant

Give Jack some
food

Plant a beanstalk

Make the characters
in the story

We will continue to **revisit** the letter sounds that we have learnt and practise using them to read and write simple words and simple sentences.

Please see your child's individual report to find out what their specific reading and writing target is.

There will be **supporting videos** and **activities** posted regularly on 'Google Classroom' which you can access.

In maths, we will



9 and 10- Comparing Numbers to 10.

Bonds to 10.

We will explore counting forwards and backwards and representing 9 and 10 in different ways and explore the composition of 9 (eg. 3 and 3 and 3.)

We will also compare numbers to 10 to see which numbers/quantities are bigger or smaller. We will also look at the composition to 10 by exploring number bonds. E.g 5 and 5 make 10.

3d Shapes and Pattern

We will explore the properties of shapes. E.g Do they roll and why? We will introduce their names.

We will look at more complex patterns, building on previous learning, such as AABAAB.
