Foundation Stage Learning Leaflet Term 2



This leaflet will give you information about some of the things your child is learning this term. Other things we learn during the week will be shared via 'Google Classroom' as a learning presentation.

We will find out about different festivals of light.

This term the children will learn about Diwali, Hanukkah and Christmas.

The children will find out...



What is this festival?

When is this festival and who celebrates it?

How do people celebrate this festival?



We will learn the story of the 'Little Red Riding Hood'

We will **explore** the story in terms of how we can stay safe outside of school and how we can help make people happy.

We will use this story as a **basis for other learning**. Here are some examples:

How did people celebrate Christmas in the past?

How can we keep ourselves healthy?

Who helps us if we are poorly?

As in last term, we don't want to give too much away as it will spoil the surprise!

You can help your child by sharing the story map with them when we send it home



We will **revisit** all of the letter sounds that we learnt last term.

These are the order in which we will teach them.

m, a, s, d, t i, n, p, g, o c, k, u, b, f e, l, h, sh, r j, v, y, w, th z, ch, qu, x

Some of us will start to **read** and **write** simple words using the letter sounds that we have learnt.

You can help your child by supporting them to complete the letter sound activity we send home each day.

There will also be **supporting videos** and **activities** posted weekly on 'Google Classroom' which you can access.

In maths, we will be exploring different ways of representing numbers 1,2,3. For example..



Comparing numbers 1,2,3-looking at using representation to support the understanding that as we count, each number is one more than the number before. Similarly as we count back, each number is one less than the previous number.

Composition- Introduce the idea that all numbers are made up of smaller numbers.
