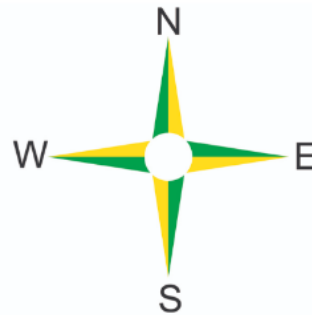

**Planning a Journey**

When people plan a journey, they might use maps and a **compass** to help them. You can record a journey on a map using a journey line.



Key vocabulary and definitions:

<b>Continent</b>	Large, solid area of land. There are 7 continents.
<b>Ocean</b>	Large area of salt water between continents. There are 5 oceans.
<b>Explorer</b>	Someone that travels to a new place.
<b>Journey</b>	Act of travelling from one place to another.
<b>North Pole</b>	The most northern point of the world's axis.
<b>South Pole</b>	The most southern point of the world's axis.
