

English

Each day we will be splitting into groups to develop our reading and writing skills with our Read Write Inc phonic sessions. (Watch out for the supporting books coming home). We will be basing our wider learning on the story *Dear Greenpeace* by Simon James. Each week we will also be practising our handwriting, spelling and grammar skills.

Science

We will be learning about the parts of plants and what plants need to grow and survive. We will be naming types of trees and plants, as well as growing our own plants to find out what conditions plants like best. Then we will watch our bean plants grow and keep a bean diary.

Geography

We will be learning about the equator and how countries closer to the equator are hotter than countries further from the equator. We will be learning about animals around the world and their habitats.

Maths

We will be learning simple multiplication and division, focusing on repeated addition (multiplication) and sharing equal groups (division). Then we will be learning to count, order and compare numbers to 100 in our place value unit.

Art

This term our focus is on pattern. We will be identifying patterns in nature and using observation to recreate these patterns using sketching and painting skills.
